- √ Follow the world
- √ Follow the devil
- ✓ Follow the sons of disobedience
- √ Follow our lust and anger
- √ Just like everyone else

Dead in our trespasses and sins.

Alive together with Christ.

■ OUR NEW IDENTITY: ALIVE, 2:4-7.

- What God did ...
- √ Showed us his rich mercy
- ✓ Loved us with his great love
- √ Made us alive together with Christ
- √ Raised us up with Christ
- ✓ Seated us with Christ in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus
- ✓ Made us eligible to receive the surpassing riches of his grace ... in Christ Jesus

■ THE WORK OF SALVATION: ✓ All God, 2:8-9.

- The result of the work of Jesus Christ: Our salvation!
- The result of our works: Nothing good.
- We can add nothing to the work of God in salvation: Not baptism, not church attendance, not good deeds, not morality, not ethics. Nothing we could do or have done resulted in our salvation. Only believe.

God works and we believe.

■ THE WORK OF GOOD WORKS: We are his workmanship, 2:10.

Now we work. Once we are "in Christ" we accept the good works that God has prepared for us.
