- Minutes for the **annual business meeting** in classroom off entrance.
- **Announcement from board meeting for February 2, 2014.** The board members wants to express their appreciation: 1) to the England's for installation of the attractive tile in the entry, 2) to Randy for the basement step alert marking, 3) to Steve for rearranging the pews as approved by the board, for replacing light bulbs and for improving the function of the basement heating vents.
- The board has set a tentative **meeting schedule**. Alternate Thursdays at 7 pm. Dates are February 13 and 27, March 13 and 27, April 10 and 24, May 8 and 22. You are always welcome to attend these meetings.
- The board approved renewing the **CCLI and Song Select** licenses for \$177.67 which covers use through March 31, 2015 for both.
- Steve Sowers agreed to be the board member to serve on the **planning committee** established at the annual meeting: (“form a planning committee to investigate constructional possibilities and provide informational meetings for the congregation”.)
- The board intends to add a new fund for offerings received that have been **designated to missions**. This money would be available for use in support of missions beyond the Missions Fund of \$14,000 approved in the Faith Fellowship 2014 budget.
- The board is discussing developing a structure for a **Christian Ed committee**.
- Pretty sure we will **begin a study in The Letter to the Romans** after Easter and after Ezra is finished. Probably sometime in May.
