- (John 14:15 ESV) If you **love** me, you will keep my commandments.
- (John 14:21 ESV) Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who **loves** me. And he who **loves** me will be loved by my Father, and I will **love** him and manifest myself to him.
- (John 15:10 ESV) If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my **love**, just as I have kept my Father’s commandments and abide in his **love**.
- (Romans 5:8 ESV) But God shows his **love** for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
- (Romans 13:8 ESV) Owe no one anything, except to **love** each other, for the one who **loves** another has fulfilled the law.
- (1 Corinthians 16:14 ESV) Let all that you do be done in **love**.
- (1 John 4:8 ESV) Anyone who does not **love** does not know God, because God is **love**.
- (1 John 4:10-11 ESV) In this is **love**, not that we have **loved** God but that he **loved** us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so **loved** us, we also ought to **love** one another.
- (1 John 4:16 ESV) So we have come to know and to believe the **love** that God has for us. God is **love**, and whoever abides in **love** abides in God, and God abides in him.
- (1 John 4:18 ESV) There is no fear in **love**, but perfect **love** casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in **love**.
