

"He Was Wounded for Our Transgressions" (Isaiah 53)

1) **ALL / READ - (Isaiah 52:14-15 NCV)** Many people were shocked when they saw him. His appearance was so damaged he did not look like a man; his form was so changed they could barely tell he was human. 15 But now he will surprise many nations. Kings will be amazed and shut their mouths. They will see things they had not been told about him, and they will understand things they had not heard.

3) **ALL / READ - (Isaiah 53:1-3 NCV)** Who would have believed what we heard? Who saw the LORD's power in this? 2 He grew up like a small plant before the LORD, like a root growing in a dry land. He had no special beauty or form to make us notice him; there was nothing in his appearance to make us desire him. 3 He was hated and rejected by people. He had much pain and suffering. People would not even look at him. He was hated, and we didn't even notice him.

6) **ALL / READ - (Isaiah 53:4-5 NCV)** But he took our suffering on him and felt our pain for us. The punishment, which made us well, was given to him, and we are healed because of his wounds.

11) **ALL / READ - (Isaiah 53:6a NCV)** We all have wandered away like sheep; each of us has gone his own way.

12) **ALL / SING - HE WAS WOUNDED FOR OUR TRANSGRESSIONS**

VERSE 1: He was wounded for our transgressions, He bore our sins in His body on the tree. For our guilt He gave us peace, From our bondage gave release, And with His stripes and with His stripes, And with His stripes our souls are healed.

VERSE 2: He was numbered among transgressors, We did esteem Him forsaken by His God, As our sacrifice He died, That the law be satisfied, All our sin and all our sin, And all our sin was laid on Him.

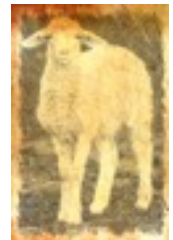

13) **ALL / READ - (Isaiah 53:6b-7 NCV)** But the LORD has put on him the punishment for all the evil we have done. 7 He was beaten down and punished, but he didn't say a word. He was like a lamb being led to be killed. He was quiet, as a sheep is quiet while its wool is being cut; he never opened his mouth.

15) **ALL / READ - (Isaiah 53:8-9 NCV)** Men took him away roughly and unfairly. He died without children to continue his family. He was put to death; he was punished for the sins of my people. 9 He was buried with wicked men, and he died with the rich. He had done nothing wrong, and he had never lied.

16) **ALL / SING - WHEN I SURVEY THE WONDROUS CROSS / 324**

17) **ALL / READ - (Isaiah 53:10 NCV)** But it was the LORD who decided to crush him and make him suffer. The LORD made his life a penalty offering, but he will still see his descendants and live a long life. He will complete the things the LORD wants him to do.

18) **ALL / SING - O THE BLOOD OF JESUS / 333**

19) **ALL / READ - (Isaiah 53:11-12 NCV)** After his soul suffers many things, he will see life and be satisfied. My good servant will make many people right with God; he will carry away their sins. 12 For this reason I will make him a great man among people, and he will share in all things with those who are strong. He willingly gave his life and was treated like a criminal. But he carried away the sins of many people and asked forgiveness for those who sinned.

20) **ALL / SING - THE CLEANSING WAVE**

VERSE ONE: Oh, now I see the cleansing wave! The fountain deep and wide; Jesus, my Lord, mighty to save, Points to His wounded side.

- **REFRAIN:** The cleansing stream I see, I see! I plunge, and, oh, it cleanseth me! Oh, praise the Lord, it cleanseth me! It cleanseth me, yes, cleanseth me.
