For it is no empty word for you, but your very life, and by this word you shall live long in the land that you are going over the Jordan to possess."</li> <li>(Leviticus 18:4-5 ESV) You shall follow my rules and keep my statutes and my rules; if a person does them, he shall live by them: I am the LORD your God. I gave them my statutes and made known to them my rules, by which, if a person does them, he shall live.</li> <li>(Psalm 119:17 ESV) Deal bountifully with your servant, that I may live and keep your word.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>(Romans 3:27-28 ESV) Then what becomes of our boasting? It is excluded. By what kind of law? By a law of works? No, but by the law of faith. For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law.</li> <li>(Galatians 2:16 ESV) Yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified.</li> <li>(Galatians 2:21 ESV) I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose.</li> <li>(Galatians 3:10-14 ESV) For all who rely on works of the law are under a curse; for it is written, "Cursed be everyone who does not abide by all things written in the Book of the Law, and do them." Now it is evident that no one is justified before God by the law, for "The righteous shall live by faith."</li> <li>(Galatians 3:21-22 ESV) Is the law then contrary to the promises of God? Certainly not! For if a law had been given that could give life, would indeed be by the Scripture imprisoned under sin, so that the faith in Jesus Christ to those who believe.</li> </ul>
