How did the Jews miss these blessings of God?

They didn't receive God's words. They didn't receive the teaching of Moses.
 They didn't receive the teaching of Jesus Christ.

Receiving the words ...

- (Proverbs 2:1 ESV) My son, <u>if you receive my words</u> and treasure up my commandments with you.
- (Ezekiel 3:7 ESV) But the house of Israel will <u>not be willing to listen</u> to you, for they are <u>not willing to listen</u> to me: because all the house of Israel have a hard forehead and a stubborn heart.
- (John 12:48 ESV) The one who rejects me and <u>does not receive my</u>
 words has a judge; the word that I have spoken will judge him on the
 last day.
- (Jeremiah 35:13 ESV) Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel:
 Go and say to the people of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem,
 Will you not receive instruction and listen to my words? declares the LORD.
- (John 17:8 ESV) For I have given them the words that you gave me, and
 <u>they have received them</u> and have come to know in truth that I came
 from you; and they have believed that you sent me.

If you believed Moses ...

- Moses ... (John 5:46-47 ESV) For <u>if you believed Moses</u>, you would believe me; for he wrote of me. But if you do not believe his writings, how will you believe my words?
- → Moses ... (Luke 24:27 ESV) And <u>beginning with Moses</u> and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself.
- → Moses ... (Luke 24:44 ESV) Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled."
- → Moses ... (John 7:19 ESV) Has not Moses given you the law? Yet none of you keeps the law. Why do you seek to kill me?
- → Moses ... (John 9:28-30 ESV) And they reviled him, saying, "You are his disciple, but we are <u>disciples of Moses</u>. We know that God has spoken to Moses, but as for this man, we do not know where he comes from." The man answered, "Why, this is <u>an amazing thing!</u>

 You do not know where he comes from, and yet he opened my eyes."

▶ Israel chose their story over the Story of God.

- Missing God's Story was not new to the Jewish people.
- At one time Elijah wondered if he was the only one left true to God (1 Kings 19:10, Romans 11:2-4).
- The people of Israel (north and south kingdoms) were ravaged and sent off to foreign lands as captives as God's judgment on their rebellion.

But ... They tried to keep the parts of God's Story that fit their story.

They kept the teaching of Moses but not really ...

▶ And in the process ... They lost God's Story.

- (Jeremiah 23:36 NCV) But you will never again say, 'The message of the LORD,' because <u>the only message you speak is your own words</u>. You have changed the words of our God, the living God, the LORD All-Powerful.
- (Jeremiah 23:36 NKJV) And the oracle of the LORD you shall mention no more. For every man's word will be his oracle, for you have perverted the words of the living God, the LORD of hosts, our God.

► How do we learn from their mistakes?

- We <u>receive</u> our "information" from God, and we <u>deliver</u> what we <u>receive</u> from God.
- No editing. No adding or subtracting.
- (Deuteronomy 4:2 ESV) You <u>shall not add</u> to the word that I command you, <u>nor take from it</u>, that you may keep the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you.
- (Deuteronomy 12:32 ESV) Everything that I command you, you shall be careful to do. <u>You shall not add to it</u> or take from it.
