- (1) This beginning is God's literal, material creation of heaven and earth and the beginning of "time" as we know it.
 - <u>One</u> eye-witness to creation ...

—(Job 38:4–5 ESV) Where were you when I laid the foundation of the earth? Tell me, if you have understanding. Who determined its measurements surely you know! Or who stretched the line upon it?

<u>One Person</u> who truly knows the laws of the universe ...
—(Job 38:33 NLT) Do you know the laws of the universe? Can you use them to regulate the earth?

(2) This beginning is Chapter One in God's authoritative account of human history and destiny.

- History: the study of past events, particularly in human affairs; the past, former times, historical events, the olden days, the old days, bygone days, long ago, yesterday, antiquity; the whole series of past events connected with someone or something; a continuous, systematic narrative of past events as relating to a particular people, country, period, person, etc., usually written as a chronological account; the aggregate of past events; the record of past events and times, especially in connection with the human race.
- Destiny: The events that will necessarily happen to a particular person or thing in the future; the things that someone or something will experience in the future; the inevitable or necessary fate to which a particular person or thing is destined; one's lot, fate or fortune.

(3) This beginning creation of the heavens and earth will one day give way to a new heaven and earth.
