

#### Free indeed ...

- (Psalm 44:1-3 ESV) O God, we have heard with our ears, our fathers have told us, what deeds you performed in their days, in the days of old: you with your own hand drove out the nations, but them you planted; you afflicted the peoples, but them you set free; for not by their own sword did they win the land, nor did their own arm save them, but your right hand and your arm, and the light of your face, for you delighted in them.
- (John 8:31-32 GW) So Jesus said to those Jews who believed in him, "If you live by what I say, you are truly my disciples. You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."
- (John 8:36 GW) So if the Son sets you free, you will be absolutely free.
- (Romans 6:21–22 ESV) But what fruit were you getting at that time from the things of which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death.
   But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the fruit you get leads to sanctification and its end, eternal life.
- (Romans 8:2 ESV) For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death.
- (Romans 8:20-21 ESV) For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of him who subjected it, in hope that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God.
