## So what had they done? What happened?

- FIRST: They died, Genesis 2:15–17.
- <u>SECOND</u>: They brought God's curse on all the animal kingdom, Genesis 3:14.
- <u>THIRD</u>: They made perpetual enemies of the offspring of the devil, Genesis 3:15, cf. John 8:43–47.
- FOURTH: They received their first promise of hope and victory over these enemies, Genesis 3:15, Galatians 3:19.
- <u>FIFTH</u>: The woman's pain in childbirth would increase, and she would struggle in her role of submission to her husband, Genesis 3:16.
- <u>SIXTH</u>: The ground is cursed because of Adam, Genesis 3:17-19.
