## ■ OCCURRENCES OF THE PHRASE—"APOCALYPSE JESUS CHRIST"

- (1 Corinthians 1:7 ESV) So that you are not lacking in any gift, as you wait for **the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ.**
- (2 Thessalonians 1:7–8 ESV) And to grant relief to you who are afflicted as well as to us, when **the Lord Jesus is revealed** from heaven with his mighty angels 8 in flaming fire, inflicting vengeance on those who do not know God and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.
- (1 Peter 1:7 ESV) So that the tested genuineness of your faith—more
  precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be
  found to result in praise and glory and honor at
  the revelation of
  Jesus Christ.

## ■ OCCURRENCES OF THE WORD—"APOCALYPSE"

- (Galatians 1:12 ESV) For I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ.
- (Luke 2:32 ESV) A light for **revelation** to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel.
- (Romans 16:25 ESV) Now to him who is able to strengthen you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the **revelation** of the mystery that was kept secret for long ages.
- (1 Corinthians 14:6 ESV) Now, brothers, if I come to you speaking in tongues, how will I benefit you unless I bring you some revelation or knowledge or prophecy or teaching?
- (2 Corinthians 12:1 ESV) I must go on boasting. Though there is nothing to be gained by it, I will go on to visions and **revelations** of the Lord.

## ■ WAITING FOR THE APOCALYPSE ... WHAT REALLY MATTERS ...

- (1 Corinthians 1:6–8 ESV) Even as the testimony about Christ was confirmed among you—so that you are not lacking in any gift, **as you wait for the revealing [apocalypse] of our Lord Jesus Christ,** who will sustain you to the end, guiltless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- (Philippians 1:4-6 NLT) Whenever I pray, I make my requests for all of you with joy, for you have been my partners in spreading the Good News about Christ from the time you first heard it until now. And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns.
- (Philippians 1:9-10 NLT) I pray that your love will overflow more and more, and that you will keep on growing in knowledge and understanding. For I want you to understand what really matters, so that you may live pure and blameless lives until the day of Christ's return.
- (Philippians 3:20–21 NLT) But we are citizens of heaven, where the Lord Jesus Christ lives. And we are <u>eagerly waiting for him to return</u> <u>as our Savior</u>. **He will take our weak mortal bodies and change them into glorious bodies like his own**, using the same power with which he will bring everything under his control.
- (2 Peter 3:13-14 ESV) But according to his promise we are waiting for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells. Therefore, beloved, since you are waiting for these, be diligent to be found by him without spot or blemish, and at peace.
- (1 Corinthians 1:7-9 NLT) Now you have every spiritual gift you need as you eagerly wait for the return of our Lord Jesus Christ. He will keep you strong to the end so that you will be free from all blame on the day when our Lord Jesus Christ returns. God will do this, for he is faithful to do what he says, and he has invited you into partnership with his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.
- God will finish his work in our lives as we wait for the return of our Lord Jesus Christ because he is faithful to do what he says!
