THIS IS MY FATHER'S WORLD, I REST ME IN THE THOUGHT ...



Let all that I am praise the Lord. O Lord my God, how great you are! You are robed with honor and majesty. ² You are dressed in a robe of light. You stretch out the starry curtain of the heavens; ³ you lay out the rafters of your home in the rain clouds.
