ARE WE TELLING THE STORY OF GOD?

Leighton Ford in his book *The Power of Story* shares this insight:

Each of us has a story — what I call "a story with a small s," the story of our own lives. At some point in our journey through life, our story collides with the Story of God — "the Story with a large S." God's Story calls our story into question (Leighton Ford, The Power of Story, p.10).

The Story of God that Ford speaks of is the gospel—the good news that Christ died for our sins.
