WHAT IS THE GOSPEL?

(I Corinthians 15:3b–4 ESV) That Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures.

IS THERE ANOTHER, OR A DIFFERENT, GOSPEL?

(Galatians 1:6–7 ESV) I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting him who called you in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel— 7 not that there is another one, but there are some who trouble you and want to distort the gospel of Christ.

WHAT IS THE JUDGMENT IF ANYONE PREACHES ANOTHER GOSPEL?

(Galatians 1:8–9 ESV) But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach to you a gospel contrary to the one we preached to you, let him be accursed. 9 As we have said before, so now I say again: If anyone is preaching to you a gospel contrary to the one you received, let him be accursed.

HOW IS A PERSON SAVED?

(Acts 16:31a ESV) And they said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved."

HOW ARE WE WARNED AGAINST NEGLECTING SALVATION?

(Hebrews 2:1–3 LSB) For this reason we must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, lest we drift away. 2 For if the word spoken through angels proved unalterable, and every trespass and disobedience received a just penalty, 3 how will we escape if we neglect so great a salvation? That salvation, first spoken by the Lord, was confirmed to us by those who heard.

DO I HAVE SAVING FAITH?

(Hebrews 10:39 LSB) But we are not of those who shrink back to destruction, but of those who have faith to the preserving of the soul.

SCRIPTURE READING

- (Psalm 7:17 ESV) I will give to the LORD the thanks due to his righteousness, and I will sing praise to the name of the LORD, the Most High.
- (Psalm 9:1–2 ESV) I will give thanks to the LORD with my whole heart; I will recount all of your wonderful deeds. 2 I will be glad and exult in you; I will sing praise to your name, O Most High.
- (Psalm 57:9–11 ESV) I will give thanks to you, O Lord, among the peoples; I will sing praises to you among the nations. 10 For your steadfast love is great to the heavens, your faithfulness to the clouds. 11 Be exalted, O God, above the heavens! Let your glory be over all the earth!
