WHAT IS THE GOSPEL?

(I Corinthians I5:3b-4 ESV) That Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures.

IS THERE ANOTHER, OR A DIFFERENT, GOSPEL?

(Galatians 1:6–7 ESV) I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting him who called you in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel— 7 not that there is another one, but there are some who trouble you and want to distort the gospel of Christ.

WHAT IS THE JUDGMENT IF ANYONE PREACHES ANOTHER GOSPEL?
