WHAT IS THE GOSPEL?

(1 Corinthians 15:3b–4 ESV) That Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures.

HOW IS A PERSON SAVED?

(Acts 16:31a ESV) And they said, “Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved.”

DO I HAVE SAVING FAITH?

(Hebrews 10:39 LSB) But we are not of those who shrink back to destruction, but of those who have faith to the preserving of the soul.

WHAT IS THE JUDGMENT IF ANYONE PREACHES ANOTHER GOSPEL?

(Galatians 1:8–9 ESV) But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach to you a gospel contrary to the one we preached to you, let him be accursed. 9 As we have said before, so now I say again: If anyone is preaching to you a gospel contrary to the one you received, let him be accursed.

HOW ARE WE WARNED AGAINST NEGLECTING SALVATION?

(Hebrews 2:1–3 LSB) For this reason we must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, lest we drift away. 2 For if the word spoken through angels proved unalterable, and every trespass and disobedience received a just penalty, 3 how will we escape if we neglect so great a salvation? That salvation, first spoken by the Lord, was confirmed to us by those who heard.

- (Psalm 27:14 KJV) **Wait** on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: **wait**, I say, on the LORD.
- (Psalm 33:20 KJV) Our soul **waiteth** for the LORD: he is our help and our shield.
- (Psalm 37:7 KJV) Rest in the LORD, and **wait** patiently for him: fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass.
- (Psalm 130:5–6 KJV) I **wait** for the LORD, my soul doth **wait**, and in his word do I hope. 6 My soul **waiteth** for the Lord more than they that watch for the morning: I say, more than they that watch for the morning.
- (Proverbs 20:22 KJV) Say not thou, I will recompense evil; but **wait** on the LORD, and he shall save thee.
- (Lamentations 3:25–26 KJV) The LORD is good unto them that **wait** for him, to the soul that seeketh him. 26 It is good that a man should both hope and quietly **wait** for the salvation of the LORD.
