<u>Ps 1:1</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers.
<u>Ps 2:12</u>	Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and you perish in the way, for his wrath is quickly kindled. <u>Blessed are</u> all who take refuge in him.
<u>Ps 32:1</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.
<u>Ps 32:2</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the man against whom the Lord counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.
<u>Ps 34:8</u>	Oh, taste and see that the Lord is good! <u>Blessed is</u> the man who takes refuge in him!
<u>Ps 40:4</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the man who makes the Lord his trust, who does not turn to the proud, to those who go astray after a lie!
<u>Ps 41:1</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the one who considers the poor! In the day of trouble the Lord delivers him.
<u>Ps 65:4</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the one you choose and bring near, to dwell in your courts! We shall be satisfied with the goodness of your house, the holiness of your temple!
<u>Ps 84:4</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> those who dwell in your house, ever singing your praise! <i>Selah</i>
<u>Ps 84:5</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> those whose strength is in you, in whose heart are the highways to Zion.
<u>Ps 84:12</u>	O Lord of hosts, <u>blessed is</u> the one who trusts in you!

<u>Ps 94:12</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the man whom you discipline, O Lord, and whom you teach out of your law.
<u>Ps 106:3</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> they who observe justice, who do righteousness at all times!
<u>Ps 112:1</u>	Praise the Lord! <u>Blessed is</u> the man who fears the Lord, who greatly delights in his commandments!
<u>Ps 119:1</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> those whose way is blameless, who walk in the law of the Lord!
<u>Ps 119:2</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> those who keep his testimonies, who seek him with their whole heart.
<u>Ps 127:5</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the man who fills his quiver with them! He shall not be put to shame when he speaks with his enemies in the gate.
<u>Ps 128:1</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> everyone who fears the Lord, who walks in his ways!
<u>Ps 144:15</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> the people to whom such blessings fall! <u>Blessed are</u> the people whose God is the Lord!
<u>Ps 146:5</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> he whose help is the God of Jacob, whose hope is in the Lord his God.
<u>Prov 3:13</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the one who finds wisdom, and the one who gets understanding.
<u>Prov 8:32</u>	And now, O sons, listen to me: <u>blessed are</u> those who keep my ways.
<u>Prov 8:34</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the one who listens to me, watching daily at my gates, waiting beside my doors.

<u>Prov 14:21</u>	Whoever despises his neighbor is a sinner, but <u>blessed is</u> he who is generous to the poor.
<u>Prov 16:20</u>	Whoever gives thought to the word will discover good, and <u>blessed is</u> he who trusts in the Lord.
<u>Prov 20:7</u>	The righteous who walks in his integrity— <u>blessed are</u> his children after him!
<u>Prov 28:14</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the one who fears the Lord always, but whoever hardens his heart will fall into calamity.
<u>Prov 29:18</u>	Where there is no prophetic vision the people cast off restraint, but <u>blessed is</u> he who keeps the law.
<u>Isa 30:18</u>	Therefore the Lord waits to be gracious to you, and therefore he exalts himself to show mercy to you. For the Lord is a God of justice; <u>blessed are</u> all those who wait for him.
<u>Isa 56:2</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the man who does this, and the son of man who holds it fast, who keeps the Sabbath, not profaning it, and keeps his hand from doing any evil.
<u>Jer 17:7</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the man who trusts in the Lord, whose trust is the Lord.
<u>Matt 5:3</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
<u>Matt 5:4</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.
<u>Matt 5:5</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.
<u>Matt 5:6</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

<u>Matt 5:7</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.
<u>Matt 5:8</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> the pure in heart, for they shall see God.
<u>Matt 5:9</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.
<u>Matt 5:10</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
<u>Matt 5:11</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account.
<u>Matt 11:6</u>	And <u>blessed is</u> the one who is not offended by me.
<u>Matt 13:16</u>	But <u>blessed are</u> your eyes, for they see, and your ears, for they hear.
<u>Matt 24:46</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes.
<u>Luke 6:20</u>	And he lifted up his eyes on his disciples, and said: " <u>Blessed are</u> you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God.
<u>Luke 6:21</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> you who are hungry now, for you shall be satisfied. <u>Blessed are</u> you who weep now, for you shall laugh.
<u>Luke 6:22</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> you when people hate you and when they exclude you and revile you and spurn your name as evil, on account of the Son of Man!
<u>Luke 7:23</u>	And <u>blessed is</u> the one who is not offended by me.

<u>Luke 10:23</u>	Then turning to the disciples he said privately, “ <u>Blessed are</u> the eyes that see what you see!”
<u>Luke 12:37</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> those servants whom the master finds awake when he comes. Truly, I say to you, he will dress himself for service and have them recline at table, and he will come and serve them.
<u>Luke 12:38</u>	If he comes in the second watch, or in the third, and finds them awake, <u>blessed are</u> those servants!
<u>Luke 12:43</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes.
<u>Luke 14:15</u>	When one of those who reclined at table with him heard these things, he said to him, “ <u>Blessed is</u> everyone who will eat bread in the kingdom of God!”
<u>John 13:17</u>	If you know these things, <u>blessed are</u> you if you do them.
<u>John 20:29</u>	Jesus said to him, “Have you believed because you have seen me? <u>Blessed are</u> those who have not seen and yet have believed.”
<u>Rom 4:7</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> those whose lawless deeds are forgiven, and whose sins are covered.
<u>Rom 4:8</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the man against whom the Lord will not count his sin.
<u>Rom 14:22</u>	The faith that you have, keep between yourself and God. <u>Blessed is</u> the one who has no reason to pass judgment on himself for what he approves.
<u>James 1:12</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him.
<u>Rev 1:3</u>	<u>Blessed is</u> the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and <u>blessed are</u> those who hear, and who keep what is written in it, for the time is near.

<u>Rev 14:13</u>	And I heard a voice from heaven saying, "Write this: <u>Blessed are</u> the dead who die in the Lord from now on." "Blessed indeed," says the Spirit, "that they may rest from their labors, for their deeds follow them!"
<u>Rev 16:15</u>	("Behold, I am coming like a thief! <u>Blessed is</u> the one who stays awake, keeping his garments on, that he may not go about naked and be seen exposed!")
<u>Rev 19:9</u>	And the angel said to me, "Write this: <u>Blessed are</u> those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb." And he said to me, "These are the true words of God."
<u>Rev 22:7</u>	And behold, I am coming soon. <u>Blessed is</u> the one who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book.
<u>Rev 22:14</u>	<u>Blessed are</u> those who wash their robes, so that they may have the right to the tree of life and that they may enter the city by the gates.
