WHAT IS THE GOSPEL?

(1 Corinthians 15:3b–4 ESV) That Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures.

HOW IS A PERSON SAVED?

(Acts 16:31a ESV) And they said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved."

DO I HAVE SAVING FAITH?

(Hebrews 10:39 LSB) But we are not of those who shrink back to destruction, but of those who have faith to the preserving of the soul.

WHAT IS THE JUDGMENT IF ANYONE PREACHES ANOTHER GOSPEL?

(Galatians 1:8–9 ESV) But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach to you a gospel contrary to the one we preached to you, let him be accursed. ⁹ As we have said before, so now I say again: If anyone is preaching to you a gospel contrary to the one you received, let him be accursed.

HOW ARE WE WARNED AGAINST NEGLECTING SALVATION?

(Hebrews 2:1 LSB) For this reason we must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, lest we drift away.

PLEASE KEEP PRAYING ... I have still not received clear direction as to our next main study. However, it seems our Lord is leading me to share a brief, topical series on biblical giving in which we will focus primarily on 2 Corinthians 8 & 9. For instance we will examine why giving is seen as an act of grace ... and what is the powerful truth behind the thought that God loves a cheerful giver.

- (2 Corinthians 8:7 ESV) But as you excel in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all earnestness, and in our love for you—see that you excel in this act of grace also.
- (2 Corinthians 9:6–7 ESV) The point is this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. ⁷ Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.
