**WHAT IS THE GOSPEL?**

(1 Corinthians 15:3b–4 ESV) That Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures.

**HOW IS A PERSON SAVED?**

(Acts 16:31a ESV) And they said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved."

**DO I HAVE SAVING FAITH?**

(Hebrews 10:39 LSB) But we are not of those who shrink back to destruction, but of those who have faith to the preserving of the soul.

**WHAT IS THE JUDGMENT IF ANYONE PREACHES ANOTHER GOSPEL?**

(Galatians 1:8–9 ESV) But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach to you a gospel contrary to the one we preached to you, let him be accursed. <sup>9</sup> As we have said before, so now I say again: If anyone is preaching to you a gospel contrary to the one you received, let him be accursed.

**HOW ARE WE WARNED AGAINST NEGLECTING SALVATION?**

(Hebrews 2:1 LSB) For this reason we must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, lest we drift away.
